East Boston High School

The largest public school in the city, has an enrollment of 1,495 students, 59% of whom are economically disadvantaged and 86% of whom are non-white. Students who used ChalkTalk saw an average 189-point improvement on the SAT, 3.2x greater the national average in only 29% of the time. The school also saw an improvement on the Massachusetts state test, the MCAS, where it leaped from the 3rd percentile to the 22nd percentile statewide.

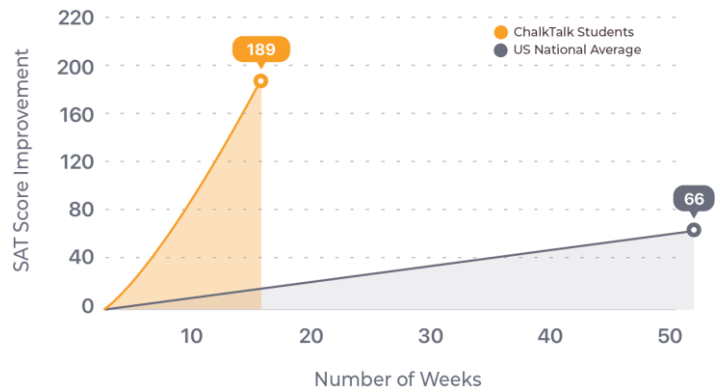

Impact Study Methodology

Students start by completing an official SAT practice test. Based on the results of the practice test and the school's implementation schedule, ChalkTalk generates an adaptive blended learning curriculum for each class in the school schedule—whole group instruction materials, small group practice and instruction, and individual practice exercises are generated for each class. Upon completing the ChalkTalk program, students then take another official SAT practice test. This impact study reports on both "growth" and "proficiency" using the scores from these two official practice tests.



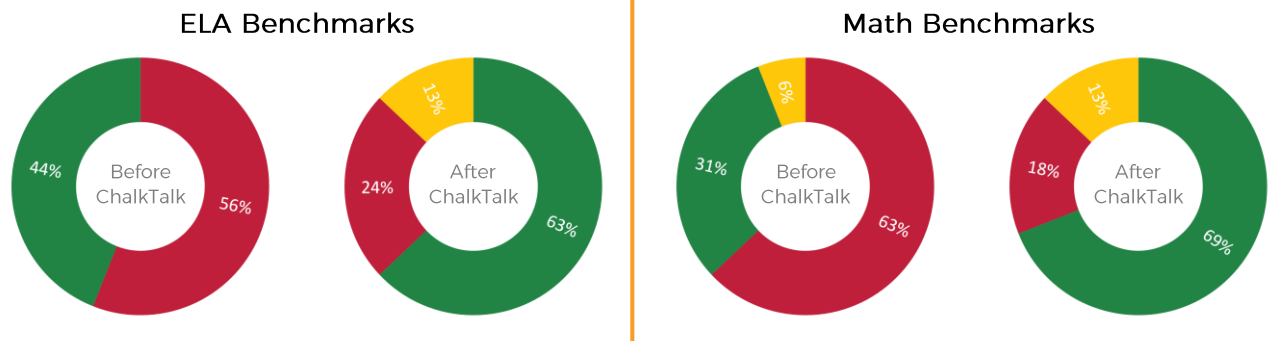

Based on the College-Readiness benchmarks, the following color-coding was used to create the pie charts below:

- : Student is behind by 2 or more grade levels.
- : Student is behind by 1 grade level.
- : Student meeting the benchmark of the current grade level.
