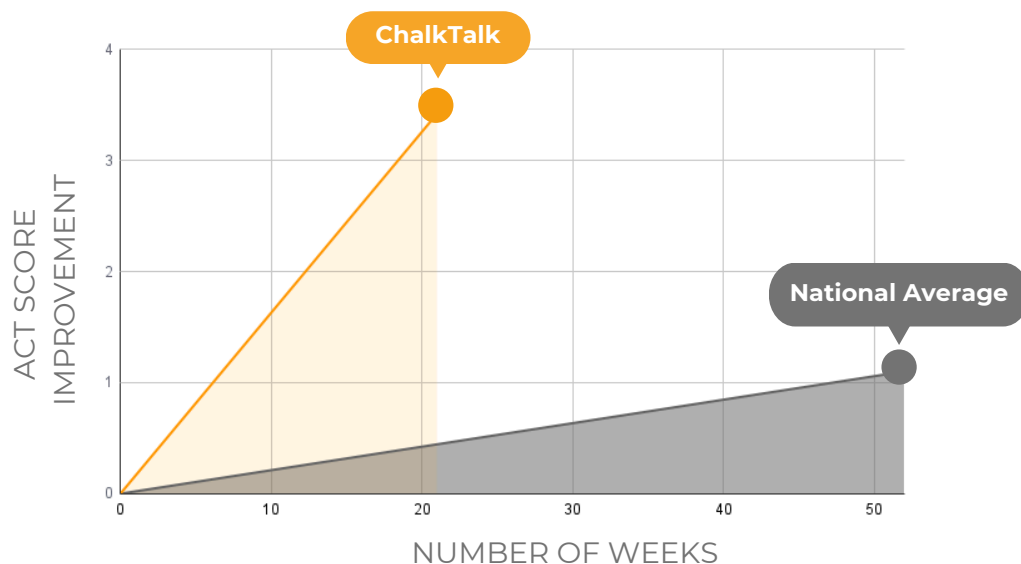

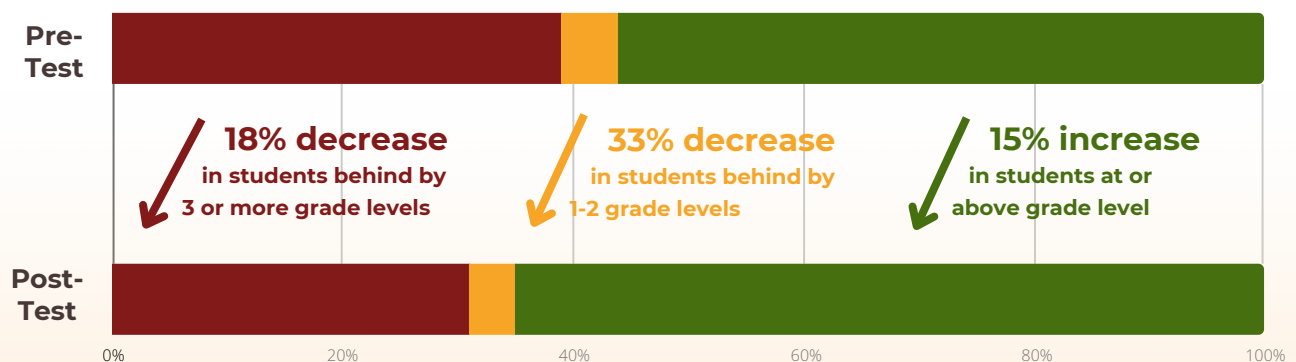
Impact by “Growth” Benchmarks

Students achieved an average ACT Math score improvement of **3.42 points**—**7.7 times higher than the US national average ACT score improvement over the same duration** (ACT, 2016)



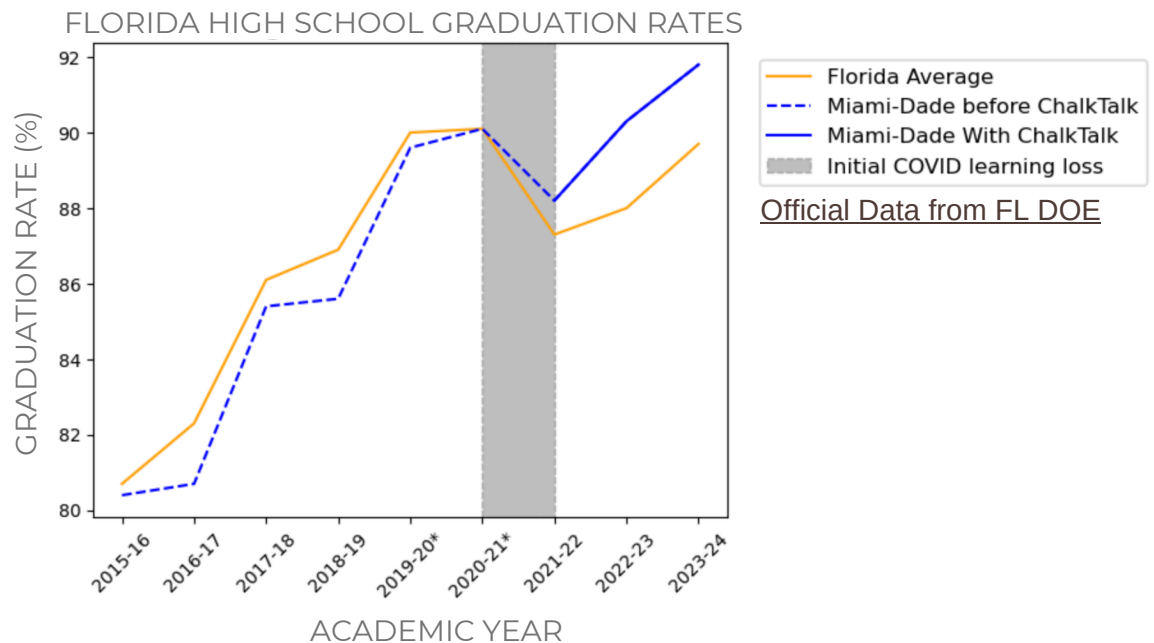
Impact by “Proficiency” Benchmarks

Impact on Graduation Rates

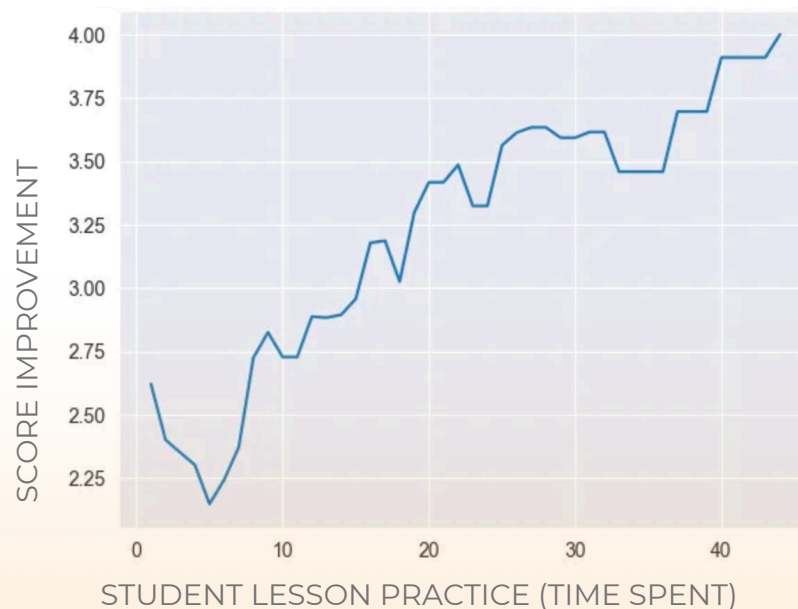
Since adopting ChalkTalk, Miami-Dade has consistently outperformed the Florida state average in graduation rates—despite challenges like pandemic-related learning loss.

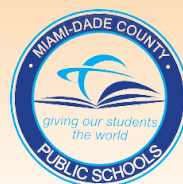


Impact of Usage

Student Population

Miami-Dade County Public Schools is one of the largest school districts in the United States and contains 522 schools, with a total of 328,589 students. The district's student body is highly diverse, with a minority enrollment of 90%. Additionally, 54.6% of the students are economically disadvantaged.

Implementation

ChalkTalk was used in core subject classes for one semester. Teachers taught two days week during a 90 minute block for a total of 35-43 hours per subject.

Impact Study Methodology

Students take an official mock ACT practice test. Test data is used to auto-generate daily lesson plans for the custom school schedule. Students then end their implementation with another mock ACT practice test.

This impact study reports on '**growth**' between the two test scores, referencing the US national average ACT score improvement of 1.1 points after a full year of instruction (ACT, 2016). It also reports on '**proficiency**' using the latest official College-Readiness grade-level test score benchmarks published by ACT.
